A Word for This Season

Hello, Friends, here in the U.S.A. and around the world,

July 11th I received what I believe is a word from the Holy Spirit concerning the season in which we find ourselves. In it is the basis of a strategy which I hope you will consider and employ. We are now such a global community, with what happens in one nation affecting so many other nations; we, the body of Christ, must think of ourselves globally as well. One Lord, one faith, one baptism, ...

Though this word was directed to me, it has in it something for all of us, I believe. Many of you are pastors and bishops, leaders and intercessors in your various Christian communities. I hope that you will look up the Scripture references and let the Holy Spirit guide you as to the specific strategies He wants YOU to follow.

In the word I received, you will see that there is something about not just watching the News, events, etc.; but rather speaking Truth into these events and circumstances LIVE. Many have asked me for a sample.

“Holy Father, You see this event happening _____. You are the Judge of what is living and what is dead. Just and true are Your judgments. I ask you to judge this circumstance as I bring it to Your Divine Court. You know what is true and what is false. Expose what needs to be exposed. As you determine that this or that is a work of darkness/death/the devil, I bring to remembrance that Jesus Christ came to destroy the works of the devil. (1 John 3:8) As You are a Covenant-keeping God, You are bound to provide, protect, pity, preserve, empower, keep Yours in Peace [shalom], pursue Your enemies to their destruction, deliver, and to bless Your people. Shall not the Judge of all the earth do right? (Genesis 18:25) In the Name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, Amen.”

Your soul cries out to Me about pain, the evil in the world: the animals, the children, the weak, the oppressed.

But you must know that the evil is yet restrained by the Spirit of grace operating on the earth; it is not as bad as it could be nor is it as bad as men want it to be as they plot evil on their beds at night. They plot, they conspire, they dream of how to deceive; what lies they can propagate, what they can destroy. [Psalm 2; Psalm 35:20; Psalm 36:4; Micah 2:1; Proverbs 14:22] They delight to do evil for their own selfish ends. Everything suffers under the bondage of sin.

Put away the evil from you. Have no part in it or with it. Separate yourselves unto Me. [Deuteronomy 21:21; Ecclesiastes 11:10; 2 Corinthians 6:14-18; Ephesians 5:6-8]

Evil will have its day. It will increase as the man of sin rises. 2 Thessalonians 2

I am watching, and for some, I in My mercy take them to end their suffering [Isaiah 57:1]; others are rescued from the traps and snares of the evil one. [2 Timothy 2:25, 26; Psalm 91; Psalm 124; Psalm 141]

You must walk circumspectly now, being wise and yet innocent. Remember that the counterfeit holy spirit works through the law for selfish destructive ends. So watch the laws being passed and those being proposed. [Psalm 94:20; Psalm 119:121-128; Ephesians 5:15]

Wickedness increases as righteousness fades and history is re-written. Righteousness exalts a nation, but a nation that loses its foundation falls. [Proverbs 14:34; Matthew 7:24-27] Make certain you do not fall into pits you have dug for yourself. [Psalm 7:15]

Where will you find safety? Only in Me. I am with you to prevail in every circumstance. Thank Me in every circumstance for this is My will for you. [1 Thessalonians 5:18]

Do not return insult for insult. Do not fall into the patterns of the world. Be gracious and do good. [Micah 6:8] You may not see the immediate result of it, but there is a ripple effect. [1 Peter 3:9; Romans 12:1, 2; Galatians 6:9]

Speak My Word into every circumstance for My Word is powerful and can change things. Listen to Me. Listen for Me. [Hebrews 4:12; Psalm 81:8; Matthew 17:5; John 10:27]

You must no longer just watch news, events, happenings. You must speak TRUTH into these events. Love the Truth and speak the Truth of My Word into the events, the news, the situations happening in the world. [2 Thessalonians 2:7-10; Zechariah 8:16; Ephesians 5:11]

One thing affects another. It is not a labor in vain. Do not just think and live in your own little world surrounded by walls of selfishness. Build the walls of salvation strong. Enlarge your vision. Get out of your "self" and enter/live in Me, in My kingdom, with My perspective. Find your place and do the Father's will for you. Start with the obvious and I will make the rest

plain. Think of Moses and others who came to Me with their reasons in opposition—no excuses. [Isaiah 60:18; Exodus 3; Matthew 7:21-23; Romans 12:2; 1 Corinthians 12:12ff]

...I have a controversy with My people who have lost their way and with it, their freedom. They think like a man and have not the thoughts of God. To them I say, be spiritually-minded and put to death the deeds of darkness and death. [Galatians 5:1; Matthew 16:23; 1 Corinthians 2:6-16; Romans 8:1-17; Romans 6]

Pray that I raise up a Deliverer—but have I not raised up Christ as the Deliverer of My people? Yet My people do not walk in the paths of righteousness to the restoration of their souls. [Psalm 1; Psalm 23; Psalm 18:2; Nehemiah 9:27; 1 Thessalonians 1:10; John 3:36]

Come to the waters and live. For parched is the ground; but in Me you find Living Waters that satisfy. Come to Me and not to the wells of tradition, man-made wells. I am Living Waters; I am En Gedi. I fill the thirsty soul. [John 4:13-15; John 7:37-39; Revelation 21:6; Revelation 22: 1, 17; Isaiah 44:3; Jeremiah 2:13; Revelation 7:16, 17; Isaiah 58:11; Isaiah 55:1, 2; Isaiah 12:3; Ezekiel 47:8-10]

Watch Me now for I am arising and I will shine. [Isaiah 60:1] *I will expose.* [Ecclesiastes 12:14; 1 Corinthians 4:5; Ephesians 5:13; Jeremiah 23:24; Mark 4:22; Psalm 90:8]

But for you, My love covers a multitude of sins and I give men in exchange for your soul. I will cause you to escape like a bird from the snare.

I love My people and I have not forgotten them. [Psalm 94; Isaiah 49]

Noted while praying for someone who is a Watchman on the Wall: Jesus, a man of sorrows, acquainted with grief—but the man of sin is a man who brings the sorrows of sin, the sin for which Christ died.

And My fury will go forth now for My Name's sake; for I am great and greatly are you to exalt Me in your praise. Be on My side; otherwise you will not rightly understand what I do now. [Psalm 48; Psalm 145; Jeremiah 30:22-24; Isaiah 42:12-17; Nahum 1; Exodus 32:26]
